

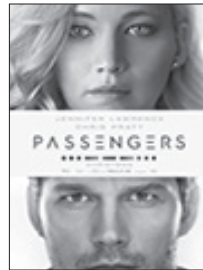

Abraxas: Guardian of the Universe (PG13) Sci-Fi

An outer-space lawman fights his ex-partner for a woman, her son and an anti-life equation on Earth.

Always Shine (NR) Suspense

Two best girlfriends take a weekend trip to Big Sur, hopeful to re-establish a bond broken by years of competition and jealousy.

Ardennes (NR) Crime/Drama

Two brothers are reunited when one is released following a four year stint in prison, but the ex-con isn't sold on going straight.

Bad Kids of Crestview Academy (NR) Comedy

A group of spoiled bad kids in Saturday detention find themselves trapped in school with no way out, wondering who or what set them up.

The Brand New Testament (NR) Foreign/Comedy (Belgium)

God lives in human form as a cynical writer with his young opinionated daughter in present-day Brussels.

The C Word (NR) Documentary

A personal, surprising, and funny documentary about the industries of death that give us cancer, and the unheralded science of prevention.

Door to the Other Side (NR) Thriller

A young couple awakens a terrible force when they attempt to socialize with their reclusive neighbor.

The Eyes of My Mother (R) Horror

A young, lonely woman is consumed by her deepest and darkest desires after tragedy strikes her quiet country life.

Fair Haven (NR) Studio Q/Drama

After a long stay in ex-gay conversion therapy, a young piano prodigy returns home to his family farm, and his emotionally distant father.

Film (NR) Drama

The movie "Film" was playwright Samuel Beckett's only venture into cinema, filmed in New York City in the summer of 1964.

Notfilm (NR) Documentary

Ross Lipman's acclaimed kino-essay on the making and meaning of 1964's "Film" by Samuel Beckett (above).

Havenhurst (NR) Horror - Julie Benz

A troubled young woman takes up residence in a gothic apartment building where she must confront a terrifying evil.

I Am Michael (NR) Studio Q/Drama - James Franco, Zachary Quinto

Based on the fascinating true-life story of Michael Glatze, a gay activist who becomes an anti-gay Christian pastor.

Incarnate (PG13) Suspense

A scientist with the ability to enter the subconscious minds of the possessed must save a young boy from the grips of a demon.

Jackie (R) Drama - Natalie Portman, Peter Sarsgaard

Following JFK's assassination, First Lady Jacqueline Kennedy fights grief and trauma to regain her faith, console her children, and define her husband's legacy.

Man Down (NR) Drama/Suspense - Shia LeBeouf

A U.S. Marine returns from Afghanistan to find that home is no better than the battlefields he fought on overseas.

Miss Hokusai (PG13) Animated/Drama

The life and works of Japanese artist and ukiyo-e painter Katsushika Hokusai, as seen from the eyes of his daughter, Katsushika O-Ei.

Moana (PG) Animated

In Ancient Polynesia, a Chieftain's daughter answers the Ocean's call to set right a terrible curse incurred by the Demigod Maui.

New Life (PG) Drama/Romance

Ben and Ava—friends since age seven—journey together through life, until a tragedy occurs that leaves their future in jeopardy.

100 Streets (NR) British/Drama

Ensemble drama follows three interwoven stories as they play out in one square mile of modern day London.

Pocket Listing (R) Action/Comedy - Rob Lowe, Burt Reynolds

A mysterious power player and his sultry wife hire a disgraced L.A. property broker to discreetly market and sell their Malibu villa.

Population Zero (NR) Documentary

In 2009, a man admits to killing three young hikers in Yellowstone National Park, only to be released after his confession.

The Shadow People (NR) Horror

Two newlyweds move into their dream home only to have strange things unfold that threaten their marriage and sanity.

Shadows of Dead (NR) Horror

At an anti-prom party, a group of teens stumble across a cabin deep in the woods, and awaken an evil creature that lives in the shadows.

Surviving Compton (NR) Documentary/Music

The story of R&B artist Michel'le, who rose to fame in the late 1980s when she signed on to Eazy-E's Ruthless Records.

Tanna (NR) Drama

In one of the last traditional tribes in the South Pacific, a young girl falls in love with her chief's grandson, only to learn she is promised to another.

Trespass Against Us (R) Action/Crime - Michael Fassbender

A good man looks to find a way to escape the criminal ways and history of his outlaw family.

Voicelless (PG13) Drama

A young war veteran moves to the inner-city, where he takes a stand against an abortion clinic that moved across the street from his building.

45rpm (NR) Comedy/Drama

An artist seeking connection to her estranged father's music teams up with an obsessive Memphis record collector to find a rare 45 recording.

Accidental Courtesy: Daryl Davis, Race & America (NR) Documentary

Musician Daryl Davis, who has played all over the world with legends like Chuck Berry, spends his off hours meeting and befriending KKK members.

American Violence (NR) Action - Bruce Dern, Denise Richards

A world renowned psychologist interviews and analyzes a death row inmate to understand the root causes of violent behavior.

An American Conscience: The Reinhold Niebuhr Story (NR) Documentary

The fascinating story of the creator of the Serenity Prayer, who inspired political and civil rights leaders with his writings during the 20th century.

Being 17 (NR) Foreign/Studio Q (France)

A bully whose mother is terminally ill comes to live with the family of the boy he has targeted for abuse.

Clapton: Eric Clapton Live (NR) Music

On March 15, 2007, Eric Clapton's world tour stopped at San Diego's Sports Arena with his all-star band joined by the legendary J.J. Cale.

Collateral Beauty (PG13) Drama, Romance – Will Smith, Kate Winslet

Retreating from life after a tragedy, a man questions the universe by writing to Love, Time and Death, and then receives unexpected answers.

Elle (R) Drama – Isabelle Huppert

A successful businesswoman gets caught up in a game of cat and mouse as she tracks down the unknown man who raped her.

Fences (PG13) Drama – Denzel Washington, Viola Davis

A working-class African-American father tries to raise his family in the 1950s, while coming to terms with the events of his life.

Gary Numan: Android in La La Land (NR) Documentary

1970s recording superstar Gary Numan's struggle with fame and his Asperger's syndrome is detailed in this revealing documentary.

Johnny Frank Garrett's Last Word (NR) Horror

When a young man is executed for committing murder, he leaves behind a curse letter, promising vengeance for all those connected to his unfair trial.

Minimalism (NR) Documentary

Subtitled "A Documentary About the Important Things," this film asks the question: How might your life be better with less?

Passengers (PG13) Sci-Fi – Jennifer Lawrence, Chris Pratt

A spaceship heading to a distant colony with thousands on board has a malfunction in its sleep chambers, awakening two passengers 90 years early.

Solace (R) Suspense – Anthony Hopkins, Colin Farrell

A talented psychic works with the FBI to help them hunt down an elusive serial killer.

Stranded in Paradise (NR) Comedy/Romance

When a driven HR exec loses her high-powered job, she travels to Puerto Rico in an attempt to save her career at a business conference.

Stray Bullets (NR) Crime/Drama

Two teenage boys sent to clean out their father's abandoned mobile home discover that three crooks on the run have taken refuge in the trailer.

Surprised by Love (NR) Comedy/Romance

A young woman tries to sell her uptight parents on her current boyfriend and instead finds herself falling for an old high school flame.

Tuesday, March 21

Ali & Nino (NR) Drama/Romance

Love story of a Muslim Azerbaijani boy and Christian Georgian girl in Baku from 1918 to 1920.

Alienators (NR) Sci-Fi

Two amateur Ufologists investigate a woman's claim that aliens are watching her.

Assassin's Creed (PG13) Adventure – Michael Fassbender, Marion Cotillard

When Callum Lynch explores the memories of his ancestor Aguilar, he discovers he is a descendant of the secret Assassins society.

The Brooklyn Banker (NR) Action/Crime

A banker with a talent for memorizing numbers is recruited by a mobster looking to get ahead.

Dog by Dog (NR) Documentary

An examination of efforts in the United States to tighten regulations on commercial dog kennels, known as 'puppy mills.'

Fire at Sea (NR) Documentary

This film captures life on the Italian island of Lampedusa, a frontline in the European migrant crisis.

In Dubious Battle (R) Drama – Nat Wolff, Vincent D'Onofrio, James Franco

James Franco directs this story about 900 migratory workers who rise up "in dubious battle" against the landowners in California's apple country.

Julieta (NR) Foreign/Drama

In Pedro Almodovar's latest film, a brokenhearted woman confronts her life and the most important events about her estranged daughter.

A Kind of Murder (R) Suspense

A married architect's fascination with an unsolved murder leads him into a spiral of chaos as he is forced to play cat-and-mouse with a clever killer.

Live by Night (R) Crime/Drama – Ben Affleck

A group of Boston-bred gangsters set up shop in balmy Florida during the Prohibition era, facing off against the competition and the Ku Klux Klan.

Miss Sloane (R) Thriller/Drama – Jessica Chastain

When a formidable lobbyist in D.C. takes on the most powerful opponent of her career, she finds winning may come at too high a price.

The Quiet Hour (NR) Sci-Fi/Thriller

In the aftermath of an alien invasion, a feisty teenage girl sets out to protect her farm from human scavengers.

Sing (PG) Animated

A hustling theater impresario's attempt to save his theater with a singing competition becomes grander than he anticipates.

10 Days in a Madhouse (R) Thriller

In 1887 at age 23, a young reporter feigns mental illness to go undercover in an insane asylum to expose corruption, abuse and murder.

Tower (NR) Documentary

Unique telling of the August 1966 tragedy when a gunman opened fire from the University of Texas clock tower, killing 16 people.

20th Century Women (R) Comedy/Drama – Annette Bening, Elle Fanning

The story of three women who explore love and freedom in Santa Barbara during the late 1970s.

Abduction of Jennifer Grayson (NR) Suspense

A kidnapping leads to a love affair and complicates meaning for a young woman, a kidnapper, and a police detective in pursuit.

Arsenal (R) Action/Adventure – Nicholas Cage, John Cusack, Adrian Grenier

A Southern mobster attempts to rescue his kidnapped brother, a successful contractor.

Behind the Mask: The Batman Dead End Story (NR) Documentary

Backstory to director Sandy Collora's journey to make the 2003 film "Batman Dead End," one of the most downloaded short films ever made.

Fantastic Beasts and Where to Find Them (PG13) Adventure/Fantasy

J.K. Rowling's adventures of a New York's secret community of witches and wizards seventy years before Harry Potter reads his book in school.

For Grace (NR) Documentary

Curtis Duffy, one of the country's most renowned chefs, follows his ambition to make his Chicago restaurant, Grace, the best in the country.

Just a Sigh (NR) Foreign (Drama/Romance) France

Their lives at a crossroads, an actress and a literature professor meet unexpectedly on a train bound for Paris.

A Little Lust (NR) Foreign/Studio Q/Drama (Italy)

A 16-year-old will stop at nothing to see his favorite pop star in concert, all while facing bullying and homophobia in school.

A Monster Calls (PG13) Drama/Fantasy

A boy seeks the help of a tree monster to cope with his single mother's terminal illness.

Planet Earth 2 (NR) Documentary

In one of the most ambitious landmark series, Planet Earth II allows us to experience the world from the viewpoint of the animals themselves.
