












Tuesday, October 7

4 Minute Mile (NR) Sports/Drama

A former track coach decides to train a student with natural athletic talent when tragedy strikes right before the biggest race of his life.

Aftermath (2012) (NR) Foreign/Drama (Poland)

A Polish man who returns home after the death of his father unearths a secret about the now-deceased Jewish residents of his village.

The Class of '92 (NR) Sports/Documentary

Details the rise to prominence and global superstardom of six talented young Manchester United footballers including David Beckham.

Cult (NR) Foreign/Horror (Japanese)

Follows three actresses who play themselves on a paranormal television show to investigate the exorcism of the Kaneda family.

The Grand Seduction (PG13) Comedy - Brendan Gleeson

To survive, a dying Newfoundland fishing village must convince a young doctor to take up residence by any means necessary.

Live Die Repeat: Edge of Tomorrow (PG13) Action - Tom Cruise

Love Finds You in Sugarcreek (NR) Drama - Tom Everett Scott

A baseball player and his young son must flee a brutal media deluge following the traumatic and unsolved murder of their wife and mother.

Million Dollar Arm (PG) Sports/Drama - Jon Hamm

A sports agent stages an unconventional recruitment strategy to get talented Indian cricket players to play Major League Baseball.

A Million Ways to Die in the West (NR) Comedy - Seth McFarlane

A cowardly farmer must face a notorious gun-slinger when he falls for the outlaw's mysterious wife.

Obvious Child (R) Comedy

A twenty-something comedienne's unplanned pregnancy forces her to confront the realities of independent womanhood for the first time.

People Uncounted: Untold Story (NR) Documentary

Tells the story of the Roma (Gypsies), who faced annihilation during the Nazi 'Final Solution,' yet have been relegated to a footnote in history.

Running for Jim (NR) Sports/Documentary

Chronicles the story of Jim Tracy, the most decorated high school cross-country coach in California history, and his battle with ALS.

Sharknado 2 (NR) Off the Wall/Disaster

A freak weather system turns its deadly fury on New York City, unleashing a Sharknado on the population and its most cherished, iconic sites.

Tasting Menu (PG13) Foreign/Comedy (Spain)

As one of the world's best restaurants opens for its final evening, a couple in the midst of a divorce reunite for a once-in-a-lifetime meal.

Wagner's Jews (NR) Documentary

Beneath the Harvest Sky (NR) Thriller

A quirky teen drama set during the fall potato harvest in a small northern Maine town.

Chinese Puzzle (R) Drama

A 40-year-old father's life is complicated when the mother of his two children moves to New York, prompting him to move there as well.

Corpus Christi (NR) Documentary

A group of actors who begin production on Terrence McNally's controversial play of the same name find find themselves thrust in the world spotlight.

The Equation of Life (NR) Drama

The emotional abuse of a young boy by his mother results in him bullying and accidentally killing a classmate.

Eurocrime! (NR) Documentary

Explores the violent Italian 'poliziotteschi' cinematic movement of the 1970s which, at first glance, seem to be rip-offs of American crime films of the era.

Himizu (NR) Foreign/Horror (Japanese)

Two teenagers living a dystopian existence in post-tsunami Japan embark on a campaign of violence against evil wrong doers.

Mr. Peabody & Sherman (PG) Animated

The time-travelling adventures of an advanced canine and his adopted son, as they endeavor to fix a time rift they created.

Mystery Road (NR) Action - Hugo Weaving, Ryan Kwanten

An indigenous detective returns to the Outback to investigate the murder of a young girl.

Nothing Bad Can Happen (NR) Foreign/Drama (Germany)

When a young man from a religious cult meets a family and helps them to repair their car, he believes that a heavenly wonder has helped him.

Throwdown (R) Action

A young criminal defense attorney struggles with a homicide case that is not as cut and dry as it appears while battling a drinking habit.

Venus in Fur (NR) Foreign/Drama (France)

An actress attempts to convince a director how she's perfect for a role in his upcoming production. Directed by Roman Polanski.

Violette (NR) Foreign/Drama (France)

Violette Leduc, born a bastard at the beginning of the last century, meets Simone de Beauvoir in the years after the war in St-Germain-des-Prés.

Whitey: The United States Vs James J Bulger (R) Documentary

The story of the Number 2 on America's Most Wanted list after Osama Bin Laden, James 'Whitey' Bulger, who terrorized the city of Boston for years.

Witching & Bitching (NR) Foreign/Horror (Spain)

A gang of escaping jewellery thieves get trapped by a coven of witches.

X-Men: Days of Future Past (PG13) Superheroes - Hugh Jackman

The X-Men send Wolverine to the past in a desperate effort to change history and prevent an event that dooms both humans and mutants.

You and the Night (NR) Foreign/Comedy (France)

Around midnight, a young couple and their transvestite maid prepare for an orgy with their guests precast in various lascivious roles.

Tuesday, October 2 1 Billy Crystal: 700 Sundays (NR) Comedy

Legendary comedian and actor Billy Crystal tells the stories of growing up in the jazz world of Manhattan, his teenage years, and finally adulthood.

Blackbird (NR) Drama

An alienated teenager's posturing online threat ignites a firestorm of fear in a small community.

Cannibal (2013) (NR) Foreign/Drama (Spain)

A Granada man, tailor by day and murderer at night, feels no remorse until love awakens his conscience.

Canopy (PG13) War/Drama

An Australian World War 2 fighter pilot shot down in combat must navigate through a dangerous jungle in search of sanctuary.

A Coffee in Berlin (NR) Foreign/Drama (Germany)

This tragicomedy is a self-ironic portrait of a young man who drops out of university and ends up wandering the streets of the city in which he lives.

Earth to Echo (PG) Sci-Fi/Fantasy

After receiving a bizarre series of encrypted messages, a group of kids embark on an adventure with an alien who needs their help.

The Fluffy Movie (NR) Stand Up Comedy

A comedy concert film that captures the on-stage performance and inspirational success story of Gabriel "Fluffy" Iglesias.

For a Woman (NR) Foreign/Drama (France)

The story of the marriage between Michel and Lena, as told by their daughter Anne, with reflections on the mystery of abiding love.

Gabrielle (R) Foreign/Drama (French Canadian)

A talented young woman with Williams syndrome falls for a boy at choir practice, but her overprotective family becomes fearful of their relationship.

Kundo: Age of the Rampant (NR) Foreign/Martial Arts (South Korea) A period action film centered on a militia group who turn against an unjust nobility.

The Last Sentence (NR) Foreign/Drama (Sweden)

A story based on the life of journalist Torgny Segerstedt, who alerted the Swedish public to the threat of Fascism in the 1930s.

The Purge: Anarchy (R) Thriller

A young couple works to survive on the streets after their car breaks down right as the annual purge commences.

Sex Tape (R) Comedy - Jason Segel, Cameron Diaz

A married couple wakes up to discover that the sex tape they made the evening before has gone missing.

Siddharth (NR) Foreign/Drama (India)

A chain-wallah from Delhi travels across India in search of his missing son. in the hopes that whoever took him, returns him unharmed.

Snowpiercer (R) Sci-Fi/Adventure - Chris Evans, Jamie Bell

A failed climate-change experiment kills all life on the planet except for a few who board a globe traveling train where a class system emerges.

Child of God (R) Crime Thriller-James Franco

A dispossessed man descends to the level of a cave dweller as he falls deeper into crime and degradation.

Deliver Us from Evil (2014) (R) Crime Thriller - Eric Bana

A New York cop joins forces with an unconventional priest to combat the possessions that are terrorizing their city.

Good People (R) Thriller – James Franco, Kate Hudson

Discovering cash in their dead tenant's apartment, a couple in debt take the money and become the target of a deadly adversary – the thief who stole it. Heterosexual Jill (NR) Studio Q/Drama

A self-proclaimed "ex-lesbian," Jill hunts down her ex-girlfriend to prove to herself that she is no longer attracted to her in this sexual identity satire.

Jamie Marks is Dead (NR) Thriller - Liv Tyler, Judy Greer
