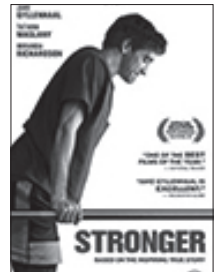

Tuesday, December 5

All Male All Nude (NR) Documentary

Filmmaker Gerald McCullouch dives into the lives of men who work at America's only all male, gay strip club located in the Bible Belt.

American Assassin (R) Action – Michael Keaton, Dylan O'Brien

After the death of his girlfriend at the hands of terrorists, a man is drawn into the world of counterterrorism, mentored by a former Navy S.E.A.L.

Better Watch Out (NR) Horror

In this fresh spin on home-invasion horror, a babysitter must defend her young charges when intruders break into the house one snowy night.

Beyond the Farthest Star (PG13) Family/Drama

A twist of fate brings the national spotlight to a forgotten Texas town, and a once famous preacher has an opportunity to regain his former glory.

Body Electric (NR) Foreign/Studio Q/Drama (Brazil)

Carefree Elias works at a textile factory, juggling long shifts, dreams of the sea, and animated nights-out with no-strings sexual encounters.

Crash Pad (R) Comedy – Thomas Hayden Church, Christina Applegate

A hopeless romantic thinks he's found true love with an older woman only to learn their encounter was just revenge against her husband.

The Crucifixion (NR) Horror

Inspired by true events, this horror tale reveals a journalist's surreal, supernatural investigation into a nun's shocking death.

Despicable Me 3 (PG) Animated

Dream Boat (NR) Foreign/Documentary (Germany)

Far from their families, political restrictions and internal boundaries, five men from disparate countries embark on a quest to live an authentic life.

Eagles of Death Metal: Nos Amis (NR) Music/Documentary

The American rock band Eagles of Death Metal recounts their experiences surrounding the tragic events of the November 2015 terrorist attack in Paris that claimed 130 lives.

Gray State (NR) Documentary

An amateur filmmaker's tragic demise is recounted in this film about David Crowley, an Iraq veteran and up-and-coming voice in fringe politics who died mysteriously along with his family in 2015.

Happy Hour (NR) Foreign/Drama (Japan)

A slow-burning epic chronicling the emotional journey of four thirty-something women in the misty seaside city of Kobe.

Hidden Kisses (NR) Foreign/Studio Q/Drama (France)

Two sixteen-year-old boys face a storm of bullying and rejection when a Facebook photo overtakes their lives.

Karl Marx City (NR) Documentary

A filmmaker journeys through the former East Germany looking into her father's 1999 suicide.

Mountain Top (NR) Family/Drama

A lawyer turned preacher must return to the courtroom and represent an eccentric old man whose mind is filled with obscure visions.

Of Horses & Men (NR) Comedy

A country romance set in Iceland about the human streak in the horse and the horse in the human.

The Osiris Child (NR) Action/Sci-Fi

Set in a time of interplanetary colonization, an unlikely pair race against a global crisis and are confronted by the monsters that live inside us all.

Santoalla (NR) Documentary

A progressive Dutch couple's dream to live off the land takes them to the crumbling Spanish village of Santoalla, igniting a decade-long conflict.

Singularity (PG13) Sci-Fi – John Cusack

A super computer determines that mankind is the biggest threat to world peace and launches a worldwide robot attack to rid the world of mankind.

Tragically Hip: Long Time Running (NR) Music/Documentary

Following lead singer Gord Downie's incurable brain cancer diagnosis, iconic Canadian band The Tragically Hip went on a legendary final tour.

The White King (NR) Sci-Fi/Drama

A carefree 12-year-old growing up in a brutal dictatorship has his world turned upside down when the government imprisons his father.

Afterlife (NR) Documentary

Paul Perry ponders the question 'what happens when we die?' through a series of interviews with subjects who have had near-death experiences.

All Saints (PG) Drama

The pastor of a failing Anglican church attempts to aid a group of Burmese refugees by planting crops and enlisting the help of the community.

Architects of Denial (NR) Documentary

Examination of the persecution of Armenians and other Christians in the Middle East, and the politicians who refuse to acknowledge historical fact.

Bad Lucky Goat (NR) Foreign/Comedy (Columbia)

After accidentally killing a bearded goat with their father's truck, two incompatible teenage siblings embark on a journey of reconciliation.

Cops & Robbers (R) Action

A strung-out hostage negotiator plays a dangerous game of cat and mouse with a cornered bank robber.

Detroit (R) Crime/Drama

Fact-based drama set during the 1967 Detroit riots in which a group of rogue police officers respond to a complaint with retribution.

England is Mine: On Becoming Morrissey (NR) Drama/Music

A portrait of Morrissey and his early life in 1970s Manchester before he went on to become the lead singer of The Smiths.

The Force (NR) Documentary

A look inside the embattled urban police department of Oakland, CA, struggling to rebuild trust in one of America's most violent yet promising cities.

Good Things to Do (NR) Documentary

The fascinating story of the small Danish island of Samso, which is on the forefront of renewable energy.

Hollow Creek (NR) Horror

Seeking inspiration for his latest horror novel, a writer from New York retreats to a remote cabin in the Appalachian Mountains.

Home Again (PG13) Comedy/Romance – Reese Witherspoon

Life for a single mom in Los Angeles takes an unexpected turn when she allows three young guys to move in with her.

Kingsman 2 (R) Action/Comedy – Taron Egerton, Colin Firth

Sundowners (NR) Comedy/Drama

The Trip to Spain (NR) Comedy

After jaunts through northern England and Italy, Steve Coogan and Rob Brydon embark on another deliciously deadpan culinary road trip

The Unknown Girl (NR) Foreign/Drama (France)

A woman gets obsessed with the case of a dead woman after learning that the woman had died shortly after having rung her door for help.

Viceroy's House (NR) Drama – Gillian Anderson, Michael Gambon

The final Viceroy of India, Lord Mountbatten, is tasked with overseeing the transition of British India to independence.

Whisky Galore (NR) Comedy – James Cosmo, Eddie Izzard

Scottish islanders try to plunder cases of whisky from a stranded ship in this comedy based on a true story.

Wolf Warrior 2 (NR) Foreign/Action/War (China)

When sadistic mercenaries begin targeting nearby civilians, a former special forces operative returns to his duties as soldier and protector.

The Wound (NR) Foreign/Studio Q/Drama (South Africa)

A lonely factory worker travels to the rural mountains with the men of his community to initiate a group of teenage boys into manhood.

Big Bear (NR) Comedy

When his fiancé dumps him for another guy, jilted Joe reluctantly agrees to go ahead with his bachelor party up at Big Bear Lake with his three buddies.

Blood Money (R) Action/Suspense – John Cusack

Three friends on a wilderness excursion stumble upon bags of money and suddenly must outrun a white-collar criminal hell bent on retrieving his fortune.

Dunkirk (PG13) Action/War

Allied soldiers from Belgium, the British Empire and France are surrounded by the German Army, and evacuated during a fierce battle in World War II.

A couple's relationship is tested when uninvited guests arrive at their home, disrupting their tranquil existence.

Stronger (R) Drama – Jake Gyllenhaal

The inspiring real life story of Jeff Bauman, an ordinary man who became a symbol of hope after surviving the 2013 Boston Marathon bombing.

Victoria & Abdul (PG13) Drama – Judi Dench

Queen Victoria strikes up an unlikely friendship with a young Indian clerk named Abdul Karim.
